David Niven appeared in films for over 50 years of his life, from swashbucklers such as *The Prisoner of Zenda* and *The Guns of Navarone* to the Pink Panther series. Despite his on-screen persona, Niven wasn't always the perfect gentleman. He was insecure both privately and professionally and used people to get ahead. But he did, he said, 'at least try to be a decent man.' He knew he often failed, although it isn't easy to find people who ever had a bad word to say about him.
