A new kind of  
songbook  
emerged in the  
later fifteenth  
century:  
personalized,  
portable, and  
lavishly  
decorated.  
Five closely

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related  
chansonniers,  
copied in the  
Loire Valley  
region of  
central France  
c. 1465-c.  
1475, are the  
earliest  
surviving  
examples of  
this new genre.  
The Loire  
Valley  
Chansonniers  
preserve the  
music of such  
renowned  
composers as  
Guillaume Du  
Fay, Johannes  
Ockeghem, and  
Antoine  
Busnoys. But  
their  
importance as  
musical  
sources has

overshadowed  
the significance  
of these  
manuscripts as  
artifacts in  
their own right.  
This book  
places the  
physical  
objects at  
center,  
investigating  
the means by  
which they  
were produced  
and the broader  
culture in  
which they  
circulated. Jane  
Alden performs  
a codicological  
autopsy upon  
the  
manuscripts  
and reveals the  
hitherto  
unrecognized  
role of scribes

in shaping the  
transmission  
and reception  
of the chanson  
repertory.  
Alden also  
challenges the  
long-held belief  
that the Loire  
Valley  
Chansonniers  
were intended  
for royal or  
noble patrons.  
Instead, she  
argues that a  
rising class of b  
ureaucrats--not  
aries,  
secretaries,  
and other court  
officials--comm  
issioned these  
exquisite  
objects. Active  
as writers and  
participants in  
poetry

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competitions, these individuals may even have written some of the chansons' texts. The unique integration of image, text, and music found in chansonniers extends their appeal to a broad readership. But for the nineteenth-century scholars who rediscovered these manuscripts, the larger literary and visual resonances were not of

primary interest. Alden documents the tangle of motivations--national identity, populist politics, and the rise of the musical master work--that informed the earliest writings on these books. Only now is their multifaceted structure the inspiration for a new generation of readers.

versatile, and extraordinarily talented, Tielman Susato carved out a distinguished place for himself in the Renaissance cultural scene. He began his professional life as a trombonist in the Antwerp civic band. This was one of the outstanding ensembles of the day, but he soon expanded his range of activity as a musical scribe, preparing manuscript collections for an avid market that developed in the rapidly growing Flemish urban centers. He subsequently

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moved on and established one of the foremost publishing houses in Europe, providing an impeccably selected musical repertory that found a ready market then and which engenders respect even today among musicians and students of Renaissance music. In addition, he was a composer of exceptional talent, supplying superb pieces in all the genres that would have been desired in the elite urban and courtly circles of the time. In this volume a group of

prominent scholars has contributed essays surveying a broad range of topics concerning Susato. These provide details of his biography (some only recently available), discuss aspects of his publications, investigate his compositional techniques, and lay out contexts for Susato's highly varied and remarkable career. *La pratique universelle, pour la renovation des terriers et des droits seigneuriaux* PRUFROCK PRESS INC. For twenty-four or more years composer Pierre de la Rue (d.

1518) provided music for one of the leading musical institutions of his day, the grande chapelle of the Habsburg-Burgundian court. Serving successive rulers Maximilian I, Philip the Fair, Juana of Castile, Marguerite of Austria, and the future Charles V, La Rue surpassed a dozen composer colleagues in his creation of polyphony to meet the needs of the court and its extravagant liturgy. This study, the first ever in English, traces La Rue's life and career, explores aspects of his compositional output, and recounts the reawakening of modern scholarship to his unique contributions.
