First published in 1883, but
never before translated into
English, this collection of J.-K.
Huysmans ' art criticism
reveals the author of Against
Nature to be as combative in
his aesthetic opinions as he
was in his literary ones. At a
time when the Impressionists
were still being ridiculed, or
worse still ignored, Huysmans
defiantly proclaimed Degas to
be the best painter in France.

He filled his pages with
analyses of the works of artists
whose genius and popularity
have been confirmed by time:
Gustave Caillebotte, Paul
Gauguin, Mary Cassatt,
Edouard Manet, Berthe
Morisot, Odilon Redon and
Gustave Moreau. Huysmans
intersperses his reviews of
these independent artists with
those of the annual Official
Salon, whose conventional
and dryly academic works he
lambasts with his customary
gusto and invective. This is the
first complete translation of
L ' Art moderne, and includes

200 black and white illustrations, notes and a glossary of artists.

‘ Huysmans reviewed the Salons of 1879-82 and the Independent Exhibitions of 1880-82 at considerable length. His articles, collected as *L'Art moderne* (1883), have never before been translated into English, probably because he is the least known of the writer-critics, and his French is often not straightforward. Robert Baldick, biographer of Huysmans (1955) described his style as ‘ one of the

strangest literary idioms in existence ’ . Brendan King, who has already translated most of Huysmans ’ s fiction, has produced an excellent version. Rarely can it have been such fun to read translated denunciations of so many forgotten French pictures. The edition also includes scores of small black and white illustrations, which can easily be Googled into colour. ’ Julian Barnes in *The London Review of Books* Bug Muldoon John Wiley & Sons Michel Hartog, a rich

industrialist, hires a troubled young woman, Julie, straight out of the psychiatric asylum to which she has been consigned for several years - to work as a nanny for his bratty nephew Peter. But Hartog's seemingly altruistic impulse hides a darker motive. He plans to stage a fake kidnapping of his nephew and use Julie as a scapegoat. Never before have comics seemed so popular or diversified, proliferating across a broad spectrum of genres, experimenting with a variety of techniques, and gaining recognition as a legitimate, rich form of art. Maaheen Ahmed examines this trend by taking up philosopher Umberto Eco's notion of the open work of art, whereby the reader--or listener or viewer, as the case may be--is offered several

possibilities of interpretation in a cohesive narrative and aesthetic structure. Ahmed delineates the visual, literary, and other medium-specific features used by comics to form open rather than closed works, methods by which comics generate or limit meaning as well as increase and structure the scope of reading into a work. Ahmed analyzes a diverse group of British, American, and European (Franco-Belgian, German, Finnish) comics. She treats examples from the key genre categories of

fictionalized memoirs and biographies, adventure and superhero, noir, black comedy and crime, science fiction and fantasy. Her analyses demonstrate the ways in which comics generate openness by concentrating on the gaps essential to the very medium of comics, the range of meaning ensconced within words and images as well as their interaction with each other. The analyzed comics, extending from famous to lesser known works, include Will Eisner's The Contract with God Trilogy, Jacques

Tardi's It Was the War of the
Trenches, Hugo Pratt's The
Ballad of the Salty Sea,
Edmond Baudoin's The
Voyage, Grant Morrison and
Dave McKean's Arkham
Asylum, Neil Gaiman's
Sandman series, Alan Moore
and Eddie Campbell's From
Hell, Moebius's Arzach,
Yslaire's Cloud 99 series, and
Jarmo M ä kil ä 's Taxi Ride
to Van Gogh's Ear.
